**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Councilmember Corey Calaycay provided an update regarding the City Council's transition to a new Mayor, Jennifer Stark. He confirmed that he will continue to represent the district surrounding The Webb Schools, Claremont High School, and the YAC after-school program, and restated his continued support for the Teen Committee. Additionally, a tentative date of April 21, 2026, was established for a visit to the Mosquito and Vector Control District, with transportation to be coordinated by Senior Recreation and Human Services Supervisor Skylar Segura.

**ADMINISTRATIVE ITEM**

2. Planning Workshops and Events for the School Year

Skylar Segura, Senior Recreation and Human Services Supervisor, provided updates regarding several items. She noted that the agreement for the Committee's mural project at Lizzie's Gold Mine is currently in progress. The Committee will discuss the subject of the mural in later meetings. She announced that City Manager Adam Pirrie offered to purchase 21 Choices for volunteers at the Teen Green event on February 11. Supervisor Segura also confirmed the schedule for Wellness Week, held January 26 through January 30, 2026, featuring activities such as clay pottery, therapy dogs, and FAFSA support.

Supervisor Segura informed the Committee that Sustainable Claremont will be unable to make the January tree planting, so the Committee set a new tentative date for February 10 and confirmed the March 11 date. Supervisor Segura presented on a partnership with the CUSD Student and Family Resource Center, noting that the Committee will assist with the new garden at Oakmont on February 25. This partnership will continue as a once a month initiative bringing TAC, YAC, and the Teen Committee together to care for the garden.

The Committee discussed potential partnership plans with New Voters Registration but determined it would be more effective to coordinate with the Claremont High School club, Legion of Voters, due to the robust voter registration program already established on campus. Committee Member Wu will provide further information regarding current CHS programs at a future meeting. The Committee discussed strategies for distributing mental health resources. Committee Member Stodghill provided resource links to create a QR code which Recreation and Human Services Coordinator Brandon Brown is compiling into a dedicated webpage. Committee Member Wu was tasked with coordinating QR code placement at Claremont High School, while Member Crisostomo will create

the Enrichment flyer for the Claremont Club and Member Zambrano will design the recruitment flyer for the 2026-2027 application process.

Vice Chair Guevara invited public comment.
