2. **Planning Workshops and Events for the School Year**

The mural project will move forward at the West Bank wall with a \$10,000 budget allocated. The contract will be reviewed and possibly finalized during the next City Council Meeting on April 14, 2026. All Teen Committee members are encouraged to attend this meeting to support.

The Committee discussed and confirmed that Teen Green will not take place in April. Supervisor Segura provided a follow-up on the Oakmont Garden project and noted that additional resources are needed and should be purchased. The next trip to the Garden will be on April 30, from 3:45 to 5:00 PM.

The Committee also discussed the upcoming Mosquito and Vector District tour scheduled for April 21 from 3:45 to 6:00 PM.

The Committee is in the final stage of developing outreach materials, including a homeschool enrichment flyer, a QR code resource flyer, and a Teen Committee application flyer.

Additionally, the Committee reviewed plans for the AP Study Session Week, scheduled for April 25–29, and discussed a “Public Comment 101” initiative led by Committee Member Pablo Guevara.


ADJOURNMENT
