2. Planning Workshops and Events for the School Year

Skylar Segura, Senior Recreation and Human Services Supervisor, provided several updates regarding TAC and YAC calendars are now available, City Manager Adam Pirrie offered to purchase pizzas for those volunteering at Teen Green on December 10, she reminded the Committee that the Giving Thanks Dinner will take place November 20, and that Teen Committee polos are ready for pickup for anyone who hasn't yet picked them up.

The Committee discussed planning items for Wellness Week, scheduled for January 26 through January 30, 2026, including clay pottery, stress balls, therapy dogs and cats, FAFSA support, and additional wellness resources and requested supply lists and preparation timelines for clay, pottery, and stress ball activities.

Committee Member Mojaverian inquired about the possibility of holding a CSS Profile workshop on December 11 or in February. Stuart Wood, Executive Director of Sustainable Claremont, confirmed the tree planting dates for January 13 and March 11, 2026. Committee Member Stodghill shared that she pulled the QR code for central resources, and the Committee discussed creating a flyer linking to all mental health resources. Recreation and Human Services Coordinator Brandon Brown proposed compiling these resources into a dedicated webpage under the Teen Committee for easier access.

Ad Hoc Committee

The Outreach Ad Hoc provided an update on recent discussions and planning efforts, noting plans to create a flyer outlining "what to do" next steps for prospective members. Committee Member Tudor drafted an email introducing the Teen Committee to local homeschool families. It was discussed that outreach to homeschoolers continue through the Claremont Club, which also offers daycare.

The Ad Hoc continued discussions on potential events in February, March, and May and will return with more developed ideas. The Committee plans to revisit the New Voters presentation in January. The Mosquito District tour is tentatively planned for March 25.

Staff proposed creating two accompanying flyers to support the outreach effort and reminded the Committee that the Giving Thanks Dinner will take place tomorrow, November 20, and noted that several dignitaries and community members will be in attendance.

Deborah Scott Toux, Commission Liaison, provided updates on current City and community matters. She reported on the removal of trees related to construction at Claremont Colleges. She also shared that the Community-Based Organization (CBO) funding allocation process is complete.
